City of Demoville - Right-of-Way Manual (2025)

In the interest of maintaining the safety, accessibility, and integrity of public infrastructure, the City of Demoville has adopted this Right-of-Way Manual for 2025. This document outlines the expectations, responsibilities, and permitting process for any individual, contractor, or utility company seeking to perform work within the public right-of-way (ROW).

Definition:

The public right-of-way generally begins at the back of a property owner's sidewalk and extends into the street and adjoining public areas maintained by the City.

Permit Requirement:

Any work conducted within the City of Demovilles right-of-way must be preceded by the issuance of a valid Right-of-Way Permit, obtained from the City's Public Works Department.

Types of Work Requiring a Permit:

- Utility installations and repairs (water, gas, sewer, electric, telecommunications)
- Sidewalk replacements or modifications
- Curb, gutter, or driveway tie-ins
- Street cuts or pavement restoration
- Landscaping or irrigation system installations that encroach into the ROW

Permit Application Process:

1. Contact the Demoville Public Works Department to obtain an application.
2. Submit a completed application with project drawings, timeline, and contractor information.
3. Pay applicable permit and inspection fees.
4. Await formal approval and inspection scheduling.

Violations:

Unauthorized work in the right-of-way may result in stop work orders, fines, and restoration at the responsible party's expense.
